Class Teachers Report

Stage K/1 ~ Ms. Sun

First, I would like to thank all parents and caregivers for all your help and support this term.

All students have worked hard in class to practise and develop their language abilities. They have all shown a great interest in learning Chinese.

Our theme this term was "Family". Students focused on developing the linguistic knowledge and skills that will enable them to use Chinese to talk about family members and relatives, such as the ability to introduce family members and describe their occupations. They were

able to create and ask questions, respond effectively to communicate answers, and provide descriptions as to where their relatives live.

During our classes, we also engaged in many class activities to assist with language learning and development, which included using audio-visual resources, such as Youtube video clips. The clips are very useful because students can continue watching them at home. We used play dough to create new words to help students to recognise Chinese characters. We also played games to support vocabulary development, such as find the words, and egg hunt. Activities such as these help students practice speaking and listening, and also provide a great way to review what we learn in the class.

I'm pleased to see that all students participated and engaged very actively in all class activities, and they made good attempts to complete all the worksheet exercises.
